The Council is sad to have received the resignation of Kevin Jordan who has served the Parish for many years as a Councillor.

Posters will be up on the notice boards in the village advertising the vacancy as required by law.

The process is that if twelve electors respond to the first advertisement by writing to Great Yarmouth Borough Council asking for an election then one will be called. Potential Councillors will then put themselves forward and there would be a formal vote if more than one applied.

If twelve electors do not ask for an election then the Council is free to co-opt a new member. The vacancy will then be advertised and applicants can apply through the Clerk. The Council will decide from among those who apply who to appoint.

If you have any interest in the working of the Council, or in working within your Parish this is a great way to get involved.

The Clerk would be only too happy to have an informal chat with you and talk about the work of the Council and the commitment involved, it is a great way to support the village and really get involved in issues that make a difference.

The next Parish Council meeting will be in June at a date to be set at the next meeting—watch the Notice Boards for the date.
