New Bleed Kits available in two Martham Defibrillator Cabinets

Funds raised by villagers towards the Martham Defibrillator Project have made it possible for us to purchase two Bleed



Control Kits from Jayne Biggs of **Heart 2 Heart Norfolk**. They have been placed in the Defibrillator cabinets at the Martham Fire Station and outside the Repps Road Co-op.

What are bleed kits used for?

Catastrophic Bleeds - They are defined as extreme bleeding that is likely to cause death in minutes. Usually as the result of an accident or injury where an artery has been punctured. The wound may be gushing or pumping out.

Who would use them and when?

They are accessed by calling 999, and are registered with the ambulance service who will advise how they are to be used if needed. Find out more here: https://raymondjamesquigley.org.uk/
